INVITATION TO BID

Sewer Interceptor Joint Grout Sealing

Sealed Bids for the Sewer Interceptors Infiltration Renewal project will be received at the Greater Lawrence Sanitary District, at the Commission Meeting Room, Wastewater Treatment Plant, 240 Charles Street, North Andover, MA 01845-1649, until 2:00 PM prevailing time on Thursday, February 7, 2019 and at that time and place bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work consists of the grout and seal rehabilitation of nine (9) infiltration defects in seven (7) sewer interceptors in the Greater Lawrence Sanitary District's collection system. Coordination of the work with the District, to allow the continuance of existing operations, will be necessary.

This Contract will be subject to and in accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 30, Section 39M inclusive of Chapter 30 of the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts as last revised.

Contract Documents may be examined and/or obtained at the Greater Lawrence Sanitary District's office at 240 Charles Street, North Andover, Massachusetts 01845 between the hours of 8:00AM and 4:00PM.

Contract Documents are also available for examination at Kleinfelder, One Beacon Street, Suite 8100 Boston, MA.

The primary means of document delivery will be to provide DVDs of the Contract Documents at no charge. If a paper copy of the Contract Documents is required, a \$50 deposit payable to Greater Lawrence Sanitary District is required. The deposit will be refunded upon returning the Documents in good condition. If mailing of the Documents is required, an additional non-refundable mailing fee of \$10 will be required. Cash will not be accepted.

A pre-bid site inspection will be held on Thursday, January 24, 2019 at 10:00 AM. Individuals shall meet at the District's Wastewater Treatment Plant at 240 Charles Street, No. Andover, MA.

No Bidder may withdraw his Bid for a period of sixty days, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays after the actual date of the opening of the General Bids.

The Successful Bidder must furnish a 100 percent Payment Bond with a surety company acceptable to the Owner.

Minimum Wage Rates as determined by the Commissioner of Department of Workforce Development under the provision of the Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Sections 26 to 27D, as amended, apply to this project. It is the responsibility of the contractor, before bid opening, to request if necessary, any additional information on Minimum Wage Rates for those trades people who may be employed for the proposed work under this contract.

The time for Final Completion of the contract is 90 calendar days

Contract Times shall begin on March 1, 2019 and end on May 30, 2019.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informality in or to reject any or all Bids if deemed to be in its best interest.
